GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All graduation requirements include opportunities for students to take rigorous academic courses designed to prepare students for their future educational and career choices.

All students must earn a cumulative GPA of 2.0 and complete 24 credits to graduate.

Once students complete all of their graduation requirements, EICA will issue a high school diploma and transcripts.

Science	3 credits, two of which must have a laboratory component and one of which must be Biology 1 or equivalent course or series of courses
Social Studies	1 credit of World History 1 credit of US History .5 credit of US Government .5 credit of Economics
Electives	10 credits
Grade Point Average	Minimum Cumulative Overall Unweighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale
